

How To RECYCLE

Your Christmas Tree in Coronado

Curbside Collection

Residents can recycle Christmas trees by placing them **inside your green organics cart** on your regular collection day.

Trees over four feet should be cut in half for collection.



Please remember to remove all lights and ornaments before recycling your tree. **No flocked trees.**

Drop-Off Locations

Drop-off sites will also be available from December 26, 2023 - January 14, 2024 at the following locations: *Glorietta Bay Boat Ramp*, parking lot off Strand Way and *Coronado Cays*, parking lot across from the Fire Station on Grand Caribe Causeway. Drop-off locations are for **CHRISTMAS TREES ONLY**. Christmas trees do not need to be cut down for recycling at drop-off locations.

Holiday Service Schedule:

EDCO will be observing the Christmas holiday on Monday, December 25th and the New Year holiday on Monday, January 1st. Residential collection WILL BE DELAYED BY ONE DAY all week.

Please Remember to Also Recycle:

Food Scraps and Organics: Recycle fresh wreaths, live floral decorations, Christmas trees, fruit, vegetables, meat, bones, dairy, egg shells, and prepared food in your green organics cart.

Christmas Cards & Wrapping Paper: Recycle as mixed paper in your blue cart.

Food & Beverage Containers: Recycle glass jars and bottles (all colors), steel, aluminum cans and plastic bottles/containers in your blue cart.

Cartons: Recycle refrigerated and shelf-stable cartons such as soup, milk, juice, soy and other beverage and food cartons in your blue cart.

Styrofoam Packaging: Recycle in your blue cart (no packing peanuts).

Gift & Cardboard Boxes: Flatten boxes and recycle as mixed paper in your blue cart.
